Special Magistrate to Hear Appeals under the Unsafe Structure Ordinance

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Windermere, Florida, adopted Ordinance No. 2014-03 on April 22, 2014, which added a new article to Chapter 6 of the Town of Windermere's Code of Ordinances regulating unsafe structures within the Town of Windermere.

Whereas, section 6-10 of the Town's Code of Ordinances provides that the "special magistrate" means the person or persons designated by the town council who is also given authority to hear appeals regarding a notice and order of condemnation and or demolition.

Whereas, the Town Council now desires to designate such special magistrate.

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Windermere, Florida:

The Town Council hereby designates the "special magistrate" defined by section 6-10 of the town's Code of Ordinances to be the same individual that serves as the "special magistrate" appointed by the Town Council from time-to-time as contemplated by section 162.03 of the Florida Statutes and under section 11.06.00 of the town's Land Development Code.


