

RESOLUTION 2016-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A FLORIDA RECREATION DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FRDAP) GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) FOR THE 2017-2018 PROGRAM YEAR

WHEREAS, the Town of Windermere desires to submit an application to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection that requests funding from the Florida Recreation Development Grant Program (FRDAP) for the benefit of local residents; and

WHEREAS, there is a present and growing need for outdoor recreational opportunities among persons of all ages within the Town of Windermere, Florida and among those visiting the area; and


WHEREAS, meeting the increasing demand for recreational opportunities can best be met with outdoor recreation improvements to **(Central and Fernwood Park)** which is located in the Town of Windermere, Florida, as detailed in the FY2017-2018 FRDAP Grant Application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Windermere Town Council, as follows:

1. That the Town of Windermere hereby authorizes the filing of an application for FRDAP grant funding; and
2. That the Mayor, or the Town Manager on his behalf, is hereby authorized to execute all documents required in connection with the filing of said application.

Upon motion made by Councilor Robert McKinley, and seconded by Councilor Jim O'Brien, this Resolution was passed and adopted by the Town Council of the Town of Windermere, Florida, at a Town Council meeting held on August 9, 2016.
