Election Canvassing Minutes


March 12, 2019

Present at the Orange County Supervisor of Elections Office, 119 W Kaley Street, Orlando, Florida, were Mayor Gary Bruhn, Council member Chris Sapp, Council member Andy Williams, and Town Clerk Dorothy Burkhalter.

Canvassing of one ballot began at 6:48pm. Clerk Burkhalter advised the board that one ballot needed canvassing. She explained that the signature on the envelope did not match the name on the envelope. Clerk Burkhalter further explained that earlier at the polling location, a resident came in and stated that his wife used his envelope to mail in her ballot. He also stated she signed her name his envelope. Clerk Burkhalter stated that the resident stated that their ballots got mixed up. The resident also stated that he did not mail a ballot back in. This was verified that he had not mailed his ballot back in. With this being explained, the Board approved the ballot. A few minutes later, an Election staff member came to the table. She explained that the spouse did not receive a Vote by Mail ballot because her request had expired on December 31, 2018. With this being said, the Board rejected the ballot, as it was not the spouses to vote on. The ballot was the rejected. Clerk Burkhalter reminded everyone that the election Audit will take place at this same location, at 4:00pm, March 14, 2019. Consensus of the Board was to audit the referendum question.

Canvassing concluded at 6:59pm.
